ETCAsia Development To-date

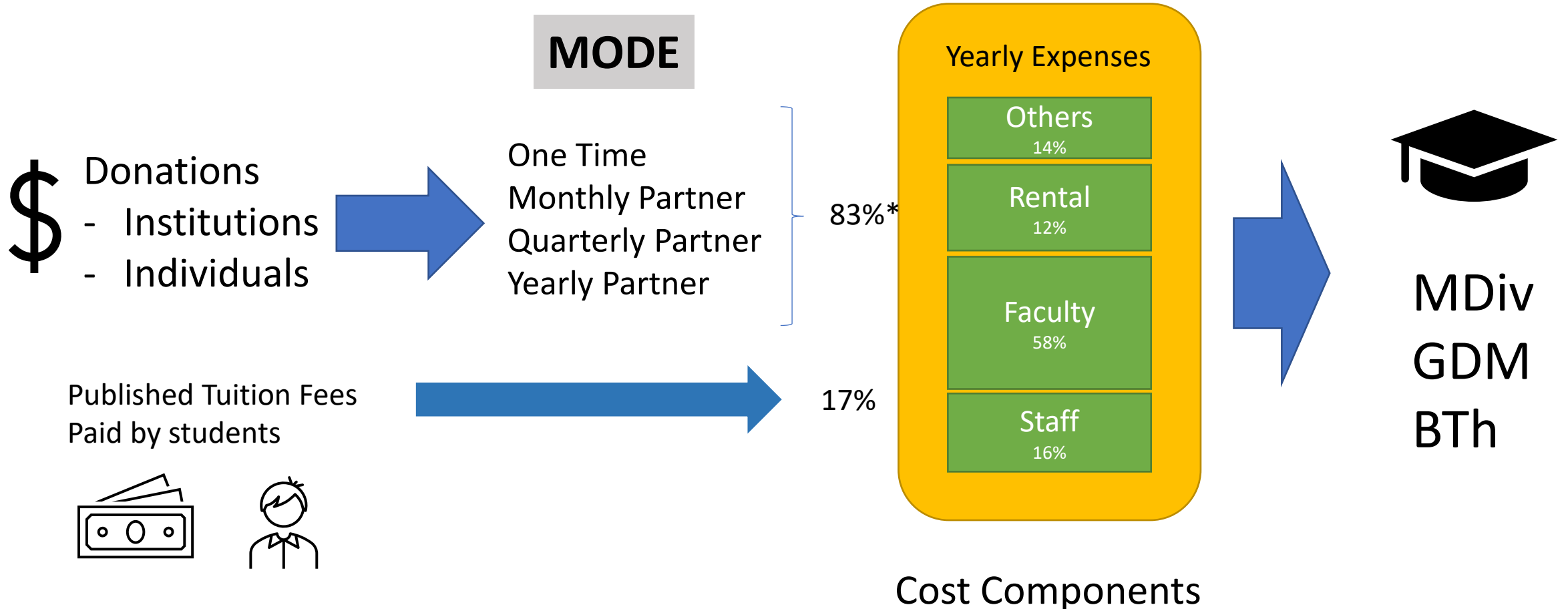
Started in July 2017

Taught and Mentored 69 students to-date

First Batch of 6 MDiv students in Dec 2020

Produced 17 graduates – 10 MDiv and 7 GDM graduates

Financing Theological Education (FYE 2022)



- Subsidy level per student is at 83%. Therefore, full tuition (unsubsidized) cost for the 3-years MDiv program is \$122K.

To build up a full fledge faculty by 2024 with 4 to 6 members

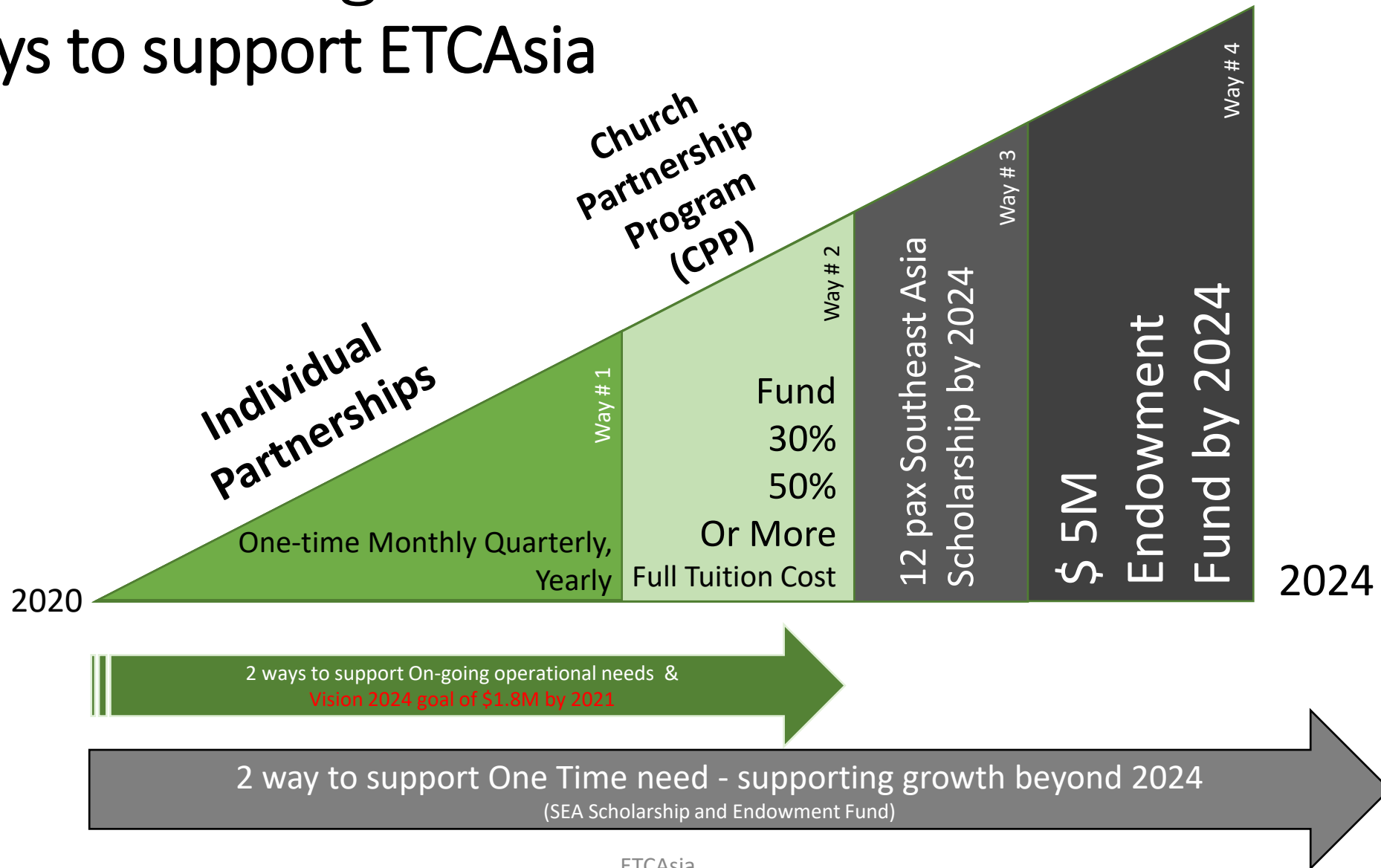
To teach and mentor a full-time 60 Full time students

*To-date about \$400K has been raised.

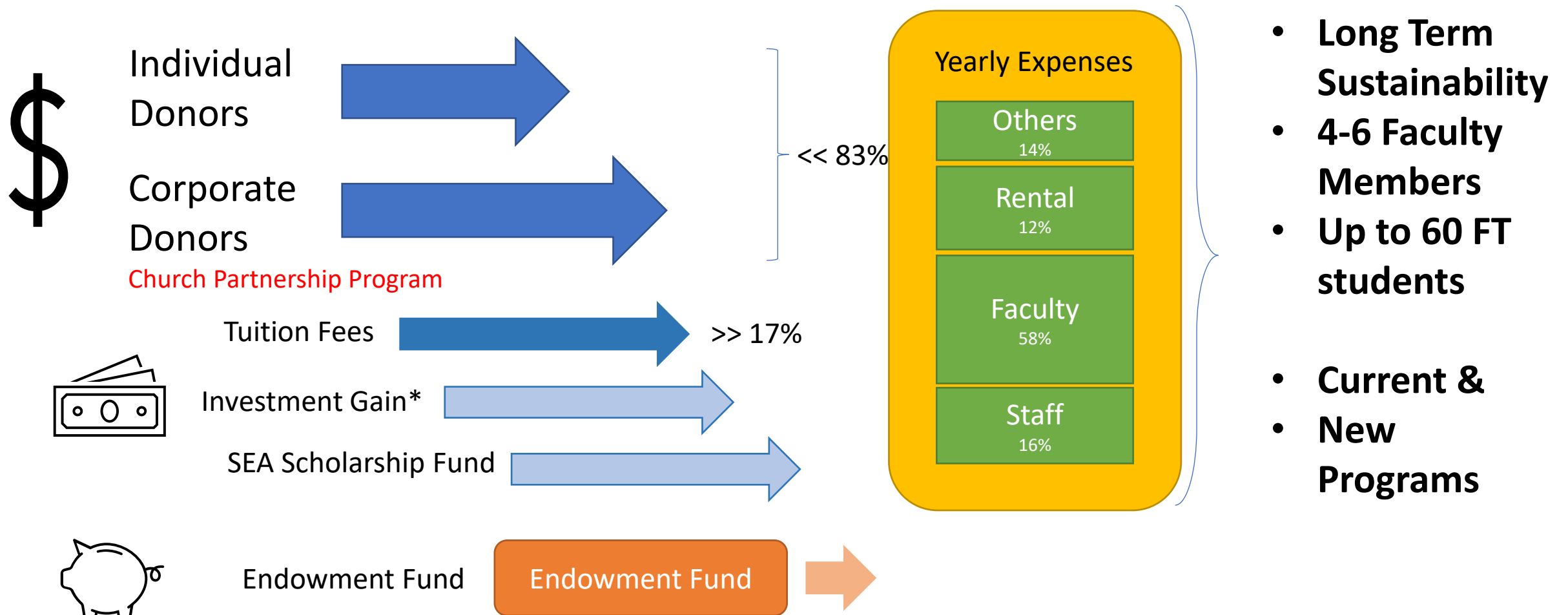

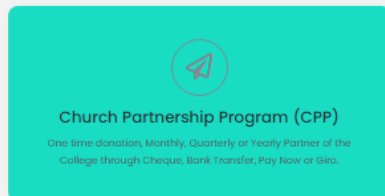
Towards Vision 2024 of the College

Church Partnership Program (CPP)

From the founding of the College in 2017, by God's grace we have been dependent on donations for **about 80%** of our yearly expenses. The remaining amount mostly comes from the published tuition fees of the enrolled students.

This means that the **published tuition fees** payable for MDiv, GDM or BTh course is subsidized at about 80% or more per student each year.

ETCAsia would like to invite Churches to partner us in this worthy cause of training of gospel workers be it for your own seminary student or the wider church at large by considering **gifting between 30% to 50% of the full tuition cost for each student or more** on a yearly basis. Any amount would be an encouragement to us. This would go a long way to strength our foundation for the future.

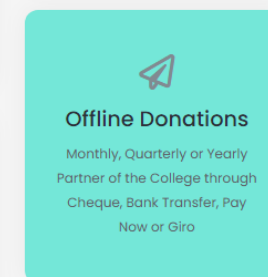
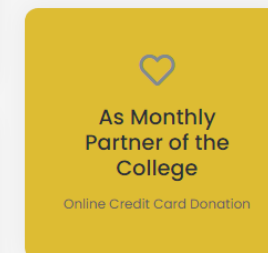
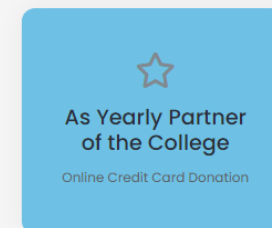
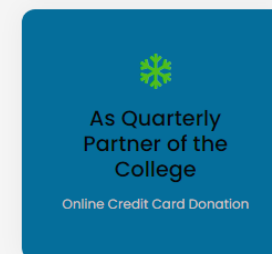
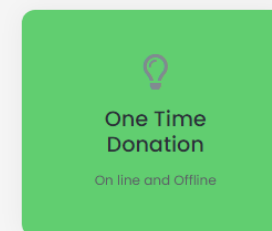

Towards Vision 2024 of the College

Donate - Individual

Supporting **ETCAsia** means upholding a College that is **Reformed and Evangelical** in conviction which many of you hold dear, having Integrated Training for **Expository Preaching** being backed by Robust and Informed **Biblical Theology** and one that is **fully committed to Mission for Asia** for the extension of God's Kingdom from Singapore. Given that we derive about 80% of our funding support each year from financial gifts, therefore without your continuous prayers support and financial gifting, much of what happens here would not be possible.



Ways to partner ETCAsia (2/2)

South East Asia Scholarship Fund

In line with **Vision 2024** of the College, the goal of the scholarship fund is to equip men from South East Asia countries for ordained preaching and pastoral ministry in their home countries.

The full time full tuition scholarship fund will benefit suitable students from the regional countries for a 3 year full time MDiv/BTh program based on recommendation from the supporting local Church in Singapore and he is expected to be member and under the supervision and internship of that Church during the scholarship Tenure.

You may contribute in part, per year or the full 3 years program. Each year of full time full tuition cost is about \$42K*. **We aim to raise Twelve (12) full time full tuition MDiv scholarships, DV by 2024** excluding the respective stipend for living allowance.

* To support a full time student per year without subsidy (full time full tuition rate) would amount to about \$4042K per year per student as indicated at \$192022 rate. The published school fee for a 3 years full time MDiv program is about \$6022K per student. This is however a subsidized rate.

ETCAsia Endowment Fund

ETCAsia has established an **Endowment Fund** to fund the **long-term growth** of the College.

Our goal is to raise **a sum of SGD 5M**, over the next three years, by 2024. This will be separated from the general fund, of which we aim to raise \$1.8M by 2021, by God's grace, in order to support the **Vision 2024** of the College in the near term.

The **SGD 5M** contributions to the Endowment fund will be set aside and will be tapped into after 2024 to provide funding for the training needs of next generation Pastors such as **faculty appointments, establishing Research Center and Advanced Programs** for on going needs of serving Pastors as well as Building needs.
